The Town Board discussed ideas on what to do with the Town Hall. Some options discussed were having an elevator put in to be able to access the upstairs and refurbish the whole building and possibly building a new town hall next to Heritage Village or having combined services with the Town of Charlotte for the use of a building together.

After discussing ideas the Town Board decided that probably the most feasible idea would be to refurbish the current town hall and the first step is to contact Southern Tier West to ask them of any grant possibilities that are available. Some places that could help might be the ADA for an elevator to be placed here for access to the upstairs of the Town Hall and the OCA with help on the Gerry Court system as the Town of Charlotte received a grant for their whole courtroom. Supervisor Crossley is going to contact Southern Tier West and asked the Town Board to keep in contact with ideas and possibilities.
